### CD's AVAILABLE TONIGHT

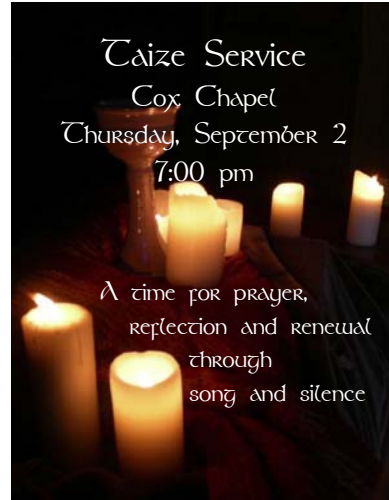
