Agape Clinic (Ages 10+)

Agape Wellness Pantry [Medium Intensity | Inaccessible: Small/Tight Spaces]

Help launch the Wellness Pantry, a program integrating food as medicine with health monitoring for patients managing chronic conditions. Volunteers will organize pantry space, assemble shelving, prepare food and outreach supplies (sourced through North Texas Food Bank), and assemble wellness kits.

Austin Street Center (All Ages)

Activities with Sisterhood [Low Intensity | Fully Accessible]

Only women and children may volunteer.

Help facilitate a fun morning of bingo and serve lunch for Sisterhood—a group of women rebuilding their lives after trauma.

Campus Support [Low Intensity | Fully Accessible]

Assist with cleaning, organizing donations, and general campus upkeep.

The Table: Deep Clean the Chapel [Medium Intensity | Fully Accessible]

Support HPUMC's missional church, The Table, by cleaning the chapel and picking up the grounds.

Christ's Foundry (Ages 4+)

Campus Beautification [Medium Intensity | Fully Accessible]

Paint the playground fencing, sanctuary, and entryway walls, and replace wood trim.

Children's Day Goody Bags [Low Intensity | Fully Accessible]

Prepare celebratory bags for Children's Day, a holiday celebrated across Latin America on April 30.

Curb Appeal (Ages 14+) 9:30 am–3 pm

Home Refresh [High Intensity | Moderately Accessible: Rough Terrain]

Work alongside St. Luke "Community" UMC to revitalize a home through landscaping, painting, and cleanup.

Dallas Hope Charities (All Ages)

Powering Hope Community Cleanup [Medium Intensity | Fully Accessible]

Support Dallas Hope Charities with enhancements to the living environment of clients at The Hope Center, a transitional living program for young adults of the LGBTQ community experiencing homelessness. Projects will include interior reorganizing and updating, exterior restoration and shed assembly.

Dickinson Place *(All Ages)*

Garden Refresh *[Low Intensity | Fully Accessible]*

Help Dickinson launch a fruit and vegetable garden on their back patio, which will provide an ongoing activity for residents.

Bingo *[Low Intensity | Fully Accessible]*

Lead a fun bingo game with residents.

HPUMC *(All Ages)*

HPUMC Projects *[Low Intensity | Fully Accessible]*

Pack kits for Genesis Women's Shelter and hygiene kits for The Table, assemble Easter eggs for Charles Rice Learning Center, and prepare Bible Reading Plan materials.

Hope Supply Co. *(Ages 10+)*

Warehouse Sorting & Packing *[Low-Medium Intensity | Fully Accessible]*

Sort donations, pack diapers, and assemble hygiene kits for children experiencing homelessness.

Literacy Achieves *(Ages 12+)*

Campus Beautification Project 1A *[Medium Intensity | Fully Accessible]*

Assist with gardening, weeding, planting, and mulching.

Campus Beautification Project 1B *[Low Intensity | Fully Accessible]*

Decorate the playground fence by weaving colorful plastic bags through it.

Campus Beautification Project 2 *[Medium Intensity | Fully Accessible]*

Create a welcoming patio space by planting flowers, installing a privacy screen, and arranging benches and other decor.

Project Transformation North Texas *(All Ages)*

Book Coding *[Low Intensity | Fully Accessible]*

Label books by reading level for after-school and summer literacy programs.

Reading Activity Kits *[Low Intensity | Fully Accessible]*

Assemble literacy kits for kids in after-school and summer programs.

The Rise School of Dallas *(Ages 12+)*

Butterfly Garden Project *[Medium Intensity | Fully Accessible]*

Plant gardens, organize tools, and improve outdoor learning areas.

St. Philip's School & Community Center *(All Ages)*

Gardening Project *[High Intensity | Fully Accessible]*

Clean and prep the garden for spring planting.

Painting & Staining Projects *[Medium Intensity | Fully Accessible]*

Help with various painting and staining projects around the school, as well as painting the fences around the senior living community.

Campus Beautification *[High Intensity | Moderately Accessible: Landscaping Tools, Rough Terrain]*

Trim bushes, install mulch, plant flowers, rake and pick up leaves, remove foliage from fences, and edge the sidewalks.

Organization Project *[Low Intensity | Fully Accessible]*

Organize materials for community services programming.

Texans on Mission *(Ages 13+)*

Bed Kits for Underserved Families *[Medium-High Intensity | Moderately Accessible: Tools, Cords]*
Sand and stain bed kit materials for families in the Rio Grande Valley.

Wesley-Rankin *(Ages 6+)*

Building Safety & Campus Improvements *[Medium Intensity | Inaccessible: Tight Spaces]*

Help improve building safety and functionality by installing new brochure holders, safety railings, and privacy tints in bathroom windows.

Easter Care Bags *[Medium Intensity | Inaccessible: Tight Spaces]*

Assemble Easter care bags for older adults for the Easter break, including activity packets and pantry items.

Easter Egg Hunt Setup *[Medium Intensity | Inaccessible: Tight Spaces]*

Stuff and hide Easter eggs for Scholars Literacy students for an Easter egg hunt later that morning.

Wilkinson Center *(Ages 12+)*

Kit Assembly: Baby Bags *[Low Intensity | Fully Accessible]*

Help assemble baby bags with diapers, formula, baby bottles, blankets, wipes, and more, which will be given to families.

Deep Clean *[Medium Intensity | Inaccessible: Tight Spaces]*

Assist with a deep clean of Wilkinson Center's food pantry.
